

## SHORE SIDE ACTIVITIES for RTC

If you haven't done the race before the following information may be very helpful to you and your crew. Please have a representative from your boat at the Skippers Meeting. We will be video-televasting to Anacortes YC from OIYC. Skippers meeting is at 7PM

Friday Night: Rendezvous and Skippers meeting at OIYC

The Orcas Island Yacht Club is located in West Sound on Orcas Island. The Yacht Club Dock is located just north of West Sound Marina. There is room for 6, 50ft boats to tie to the dock, and you can raft off that. There is also the County Dock directly east of the OIYC dock, room for 4, 40footers (or 1 "Martha" and 2, 40 footers). Space available, you may also moor at West Sound Marina, 376-2314. Additionally, Rosario is offering free moorage for RTC boats. Call in advance, ask for the Harbor Manager.

If you are walking on the ferry, we will meet the 3:40PM and the 6:30 ferries that depart from Anacortes. Call if you need a ride. Call West Sound Marina, first, if that doesn't work, text Betsy Wareham.

OIYC will open the clubhouse around 1700. There will be free heavy hors'doeuvres and a no host bar. We will have 2 kegs of free beer. Skippers meeting will be approx 7PM.

If you want a sit down dinner, the closest is the Orcas Hotel at the ferry landing. There are of course numerous excellent restaurants in other locations on Orcas Island. We have provided a partial list later in this information.

If you are looking for crew accommodations, the Kingfish Inn is practically next door to OIYC. Also in walking distance is the Blue Heron B&B. Cabins on the Point and the Old Trout Inn are walk-able, but a bit of a stretch. There are also at least 3 VRBO in walking distance. The Orcas Hotel is a possibility, as you can pick up and drop off by boat. Some boats even opt to go to Rosario Resort, and come to the skipper's meeting by taxi. If you bring a vehicle to the Island, you have many more options.

If you need to pick up crew, they can catch the first ferry from Anacortes to Orcas, which arrives at 6:20AM. They can get breakfast to go for your whole boat at the Orcas Store (and lunch, for that matter). You can swing into the dock at the ferry landing, and pick them up. You may also be able to arrange a breakfast to go, through the Orcas Hotel. (This may work well if you have people staying there Friday night)
